## PRAXIS II

- To receive the University's recommendation for certification, candidates are required to take the Praxis II examination required by the State of Delaware. In addition to Praxis II, Education of Young Children (0021) required by the State of Delaware, Early Childhood Education majors are also required to take Praxis II, Special Education: Core Knowledge and Application (0354). The State of Delaware has approved a new Praxis II test for elementary education teacher certification, 0031/5031 Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects, effective as of September 1, 2013. This test will replace the current test 0014/5014 Elementary Education: Content Knowledge that is required for certification. However, the current test will be acceptable for Delaware certification if taken prior to December 31, 2013. After December 31, 2013, students must take the new test, 0031/5031 Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects.

- At the time of registration, you must designate where you want your test scores sent. You get 3 free copies. You must designate the University of Delaware (5811) as one of your score recipients. In addition to UD, you should designate the State of Delaware and one other state where you may want to teach as score recipients. While UD candidates are required to take the State of Delaware tests to receive the University's recommendation for certification, additional tests may be required for states other than Delaware.
